

"Be Prepared"

BACKPACK

1. Tent (1 to 4 person tents are good) The scout should be able to put up his own tent (sometimes in the dark)
2. Sleeping Bag and/or Roll blanket
3. **Mess Kit (plate, cup, fork, spoon)**
4. Personal First Aid Kit
5. Poncho / Rain jacket
6. Towel or Absorber
7. Flashlight w/batteries
8. **Boy Scout Handbook** in plastic bag (zip lock)
9. Water bottle or Camelback
10. Extra Clothing
 - a. T-shirts
 - b. Underwears
 - c. Shorts / pants
 - d. Socks
 - e. Jacket (as needed)
 - f. Swimwear (as needed)
11. Compass (Baseplate type recommended)
12. Pocket Folding Knife (bring Totin' Chip card)
13. Firm'n Chit card
14. Grooming Kit / Ditty Bag*
 - a. Toothbrush, paste, floss
 - b. Comb / Hair brush
 - c. Soap
 - d. Shampoo
 - e. Wash towel
 - f. Toilet Paper
 - g. Deodorant
15. Sunscreen
16. Insect / mosquito Repellant

*Ditty Bag = A small bag used to carry one's personal effects or toiletries while traveling.

UNIFORM

1. BSA Scout Shirt and shorts/pants (Class A)
2. BSA Scout cap or hat
3. Troop Activity T-Shirt (Class B)
4. BSA Belt

OPTIONAL - AS NEEDED

1. Camping sleeping pad or Air mattress
2. Compact camp pillow
3. Eye Glasses/contacts
4. Medication – Contact Scoutmaster
5. Money – Consult Scoutmaster
6. Personal snacks (no peanuts)
7. Utility use cap or hat
8. Pre-moistened wipes
9. Work or gardening gloves used for service projects
10. Extra plastic bags for dirty cloths

Reminder: Unless authorized, do not bring any electronic devices such as mp3 players and gaming devices (ie. ipod, iPad, DS, DSI). Cell phones should be put away and not used for games and mp3 players. Cell phones shall be used for necessary phone calls only.
